Track Meet

Our annual track meet will be held on Wednesday, May 17th. We will be busing all 520 students to and from the track, and our regular school start and dismissal times will apply. We will be taking attendance at Sherwood Heights when the morning bell goes to start period 1 at 8:40am. This follows the same procedure as last year, and we appreciate your support in advance. In the case of a rainout, students will be reporting to school as a regular day.

We will be busing students to and from the event at Strathcona Athletic Park, and we will return to the school for our regular dismissal time of 3:00pm. Students are not permitted to meet us at the event, they must be on buses from the school. Please do not drop students off at SAP; students must be in their period 1 classes for attendance to start the day. All students must also return on the buses to the school, and will not be permitted to go home from the track. For any students with appointments, please park in the back of the SAP parking lot off of Clover Bar Road, and check in at the concession with Mrs. Sims for student release.

Lunch time: The track event will be considered a closed campus event, this means that students will not be able to leave the track area during the day. They can bring a lunch, or buy from the concession at the field. Students that live close by will not be able to go home for lunch.

A field trip form will be sent home on **Thursday**, **May 4th** with details of the day, and transportation arrangements. All forms are to be completed and please hand in to the office by **May 10th**. We will send a synrevoice communication to parents on the morning of the track meet in the event of a rainout.

Our students look forward to this yearly event, and we hope the sun is shining for an enjoyable day. The track meet is part of our curricular outcomes for physical education, and all students are required to participate. Students should be reminded to bring lunch, water, sunscreen, hats, and appropriate clothing for the weather.
